

GLOBAL JET A Challenger 605 joins the fleet

Founded in 2000, the Geneva-based private jet company Global Jet keeps on growing. Its expansion was particularly impressive in 2013, as 15 luxury business jets were added to the fleet. "Currently, we are managing nearly 70 aircraft, ranging from the prestigious Airbus A340 to the entire product line of the main manufacturers", says Edouard Lehembre, Vice President for Aircraft Management.
